KENDALL COUNTY ELDERLY AND DISABLED VOTERS

Please be advised that the following voting aids are available to assist elderly and handicapped voters in the General Election, November 5, 2024:

<u>AUTOMARK</u>: Allows handicapped and elderly voters to vote independently and in private with this ballot marking device.

MAGNIFIERS: To assist voters who have visual problems.

HANDICAPPED VOTING BOOTH: For voters who must vote from a seated position.

<u>VOTING ASSISTANCE</u>: Handicapped and Elderly voters requiring help may be assisted by a friend, relative or by the Election Judges.

<u>CURBSIDE VOTING</u>: Available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place. Call the Kendall County Elections Office at 630-553-4105 for information.

<u>VOTER REGISTRATION:</u> Call the Kendall County Elections Office at 630-553-4105 for locations throughout the county for the Registrar nearest you, or if special arrangements need to be made.

<u>VOTE BY MAIL</u>: Voters who wish to cast a Vote by Mail Ballot may contact the Kendall County Elections Office 630-553-4105 to obtain the necessary forms.

<u>EARLY VOTING</u>: Voters may contact the Kendall County Elections Office 630-553-4105 to receive directions and hours of the Early Voting locations if voting in person.
