U.S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force **Apprehends Fugitive in Minooka**

On February 28, 2019, members of the U.S. Marshals Service Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force apprehended fugitive Paul Geiss in the 900 block of Route 52 in Minooka. Geiss, a 34 year old male from Minooka, was wanted on a Kendall County warrant issued February 27, 2019 for failing to report as a sex offender and failing to register as a sex offender, both class 2 felonies.
