The Kendall County Sheriff's Office releases Halloween traffic enforcement campaign numbers

Kendall County Sheriff's Office Deputies working overtime hire-back details to enhance public safety through the enforcement of Occupant Protection and Impaired Driving laws issued the following during the recent Halloween enforcement effort: 14 seatbelt citations, 15 speeding citations, 2 distracted driving citations, 1 driving while license suspended arrest and 19 other moving violations and/or insurance law violations. Deputies logged 41 extra patrol hours during the campaign.

Law enforcement agencies throughout Illinois participated in this effort to save lives by getting impaired drivers off the roads and more people buckled up. The enforcement campaign took place from October 19 through November 3, 2019.

Extra emphasis was placed on enforcement during late-night hours, when statistics show the most unbuckled and impaired driving fatalities occur.

The recent law enforcement campaign was made possible by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of the statewide *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* and *Click It or Ticket* campaigns.
