Crime Stoppers Tip leads to Arrest of Wanted Bristol Man

On November 19, 2019, members of the United States Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force apprehended fugitive Terrence Mading in the 0-50 block of Cannonball Trail in Bristol, Illinois. Mading, a 21 year old male from the 0-50 block of Cannonball Trail in Bristol, was wanted on a total of five charges by two different county jurisdictions in the area. Mading was wanted on a Kendall County warrant for failing to appear on a mob action, a class 4 felony. Mading was also wanted on a Kane County Warrant for failing to appear on an armed habitual criminal, a class X felony; Possession of a firearm by street gang member, a class 2 felony; Possession of a firearm by a felon, a class 2 felony; and Possession of a firearm with a defaced serial number, a class 3 felony. Mading was transported to the Kendall County Jail without incident.

Mading was apprehended thanks to a tip received through Kendall County Crime Stoppers. Mading has been a fugitive in Kendall County since November 05, 2019.
