## Sheridan Man Charged with Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse

On February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019, the Kendall County Sheriff's Office began an investigation into a report of a Criminal Sexual Abuse involving a minor. Detectives followed up on the case and on April 8th, 2019 obtained an arrest warrant for Donald Hicks, a 24 year old male from the 2700 block of N 4251<sup>st</sup> Road in Sheridan. The warrant was for Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse (class 2 felony), Traveling to Meet a Minor (class 3 felony), Grooming (class 4 felony) and Unlawful Use of Weapons (class A misdemeanor).

On April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019, members of the United States Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force apprehended Donald Hicks near his home in Sheridan. He is currently in custody at the Kendall County Jail on \$150,000 bond.

The Kendall County Sheriff's Office would like to remind citizens to call Crime Stoppers to report any information regarding any fugitive's whereabouts.
