

The purpose of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) is to ensure that all persons are entitled to full and complete information regarding the affairs of government, and the official acts and policies of those who represent them as public officials (5 ILCS 140/1). Pursuant to FOIA, the following information is made available to the general public.

DESCRIPTION OF PUBLIC BODY

Kendall County Highway Department maintains highways and bridges on the County Highway System, including roadways, drainage systems, signs, traffic signals and other highway-related appurtenances. The Department itself employs no elected officials, but instead operates under the direct authority of the Kendall County Board. Kendall County Engineer, Francis C. Klaas, P.E., manages this Department. Annual operating budget is ± \$1,750,000.
