A Permit Is **NOT** Currently Required For:

FENCING – but there are guidelines for all residential & commercial fences. Please see Section 36-980 of the Kendall County Code for information. Important – fences cannot be in an easement or encroach into rights of ways. Easements are only found on a Plat of Survey. The Building Department <u>does</u> not have Plats of Surveys for properties. Contact your Title Company, Real Estate Attorney or refer to your closing documents for those documents. If you cannot locate them, contact a Surveyor to have a new one done to ensure proper placement of your fence.

ROOFING – **SHINGLE REPLACEMENT** – If you are re-roofing or replacing shingles, you do not need a permit. If you are changing the pitch, structure, trusses, roofline or the integrity of the structure, you **will** need to obtain a Building Permit.

SIDING – If you are re-siding and not changing the structural integrity of the building, then you will not need a Building Permit.

<u>WINDOWS</u> – If you are **replacing** the windows or doors and are **not** changing the integrity or size of the framing, you will not need a permit. If you **ARE** changing the size or the structural integrity of the openings, then you **will** need a Building Permit.

<u>UNDERGROUND SPRINKLER SYSTEMS</u> – If you are installing an underground sprinkler system in your yard, then you will **not** need a Building Permit, however, required setback distances apply to other underground utilities including septic systems. Please contact the Health Department concerning septic system setbacks.
