**AMENDMENT TO THE KENDALL COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION
ORDINANCE PAGE 16-17 ARTICLE III, 15 "Marking by attachment of a Plaque"**

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Preservation Commission, an agency of the Kendall County Board is invested with certain powers and duties pursuant to the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Historic Preservation Ordinance may propose landmarks for designation by the County Board; and

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Board amends these ordinances from time to time in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, all administrative procedures for amendments have been followed including a motion and affirmative vote by the Kendall County Historic Preservation Committee on July 20, 2011 to modify the language in the original ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, the Kendall County Board hereby amends page 16-17, article III, 15 "Marking by attachment of a plaque" of the Kendall County Historic Preservation Ordinance as provided below:

Page 16-17, Article III, 15


Each designated landmark or historic district may be marked by an appropriate plaque carrying a brief description and account of the historic significance of the property.
