## APPLICATION FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL

(Pursuant to the Service members Civil Relief Act and 35 ILCS 200/21-15)

Military personnel on active duty out of state or overseas for extended periods that include the due date for real estate taxes are eligible to defer payment of their taxes, under the provisions of the Act and related Illinois statutes. Instead of the interest penalties and costs for real estate taxes normally imposed under Illinois law, the penalties can be waived for 30 days after the return from active duty of the member of the military who owns the real estate in question or payment of tax can be deferred until 180 days after return from active duty at a rate of 6% per year. This application form may be completed by the military service person, his/her adult dependent or any other individual authorized by the service person to act on his/her behalf.
