
HOW YOUR REAL ESTATE TAX DOLLAR IS DISTRIBUTED

This chart below displays how the real estate dollar is spent on the <u>average</u> over the entire county. Your individual tax bill percentages may vary slightly due to differences in the make-up of the taxing districts in your area. For example, properties located in the unincorporated areas do not have a village or town tax. (%'s are 2014 actual figures)



As illustrated above 8.6% of your real estate dollar goes to Kendall County Government. On a home with a \$3000 tax bill, this amounts to approximately \$258.

The chart below displays how the County's share (8.6%) of tax dollars are dispersed to the various funds and organizations.
