Ordinance No. 06-54

An Ordinance Establishing Class III Designated Truck Routes on the County Highway System

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, by its General Assembly, has enacted "The Illinois Vehicle Code"; and

WHEREAS, 625 ILCS 5/15-111 provides that local authorities, with respect to streets and highways under their jurisdiction, may increase the maximum allowable weight of vehicles on designated highways, in accordance with the rules and regulations contained therein, which weight limitations shall be designated by appropriate signs placed on such highways; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kendall is desirous of identifying all County Highways or County Highway Segments that are capable of sustaining load limits of 80,000 pounds.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following County Highways or County Highway Segments shall be designated as Class III truck routes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk is hereby directed to transmit 3 certified copies of this Ordinance to the State of Illinois through its District Engineer's office at Ottawa, Illinois.
