

KENDALL COUNTY
Ordinance No. 39

*An ordinance granting authority to the County Engineer
to set speed limits in construction and maintenance zones*

WHEREAS, the County of Kendall, through the County Engineer, is responsible for the construction, rehabilitation, repair and maintenance of certain public highways under the jurisdiction of Kendall County; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/11-605.2, the authority to set reduced speed limits within construction or maintenance work zones may be delegated to the superintendent of highways (county engineer); and

WHEREAS, the County of Kendall believes that delegation of said authority will provide greater efficiency and effectiveness in setting speed limits in construction and maintenance zones, thus providing greater safety to the traveling public.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kendall County Board hereby delegates to its county engineer the authority to set and post a reduced speed limit for a construction or maintenance zone, as defined in 625 ILCS 5/11-605.1 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such reduced speed limits shall be temporary, but shall be in full force and effect from the time appropriate signing giving notice of the reduced speed limits are erected until such time that said signing is removed.
