Ordinance No. 04-01

An Ordinance for the Establishment of Altered Speed Zones

WHEREAS, engineering and traffic investigations, performed by the Kendall County Highway Department upon the respective streets or highways listed in the attached Exhibit A, have determined that altered speed zones are appropriate for the listed streets or highways maintained by Kendall County Highway Department, and;

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Board has been granted authority to establish altered speed limits on all county highways, township roads and district roads as defined in the Illinois Highway Code, except those under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation or of the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority, and;

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Board has determined that the statutory maximum vehicular speed limits established by Section 11-601 of the Illinois Vehicle Code are greater or less than that considered reasonable and proper on the streets or highways listed in Exhibit A.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the County Board of Kendall County hereby declares that the reasonable and proper, absolute maximum speed limits for the respective streets or highways listed in Exhibit A shall be as stated therein, and;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after the erection of signs giving notice of the maximum speed limits.
