Ordinance No. 04-14

An Ordinance limiting the gross weight of vehicles using a portion of Eldamain Road

WHEREAS, Kendall County has recently assumed jurisdiction of Eldamain Road in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, the Kendall County Highway Department has determined that the pavement condition in certain sections of Eldamain Road has deteriorated to a point that the roadway can no longer sustain heavy vehicular loads; and

WHEREAS, local authorities with respect to highways under their jurisdiction may, by ordinance or resolution, prohibit the operation of trucks or other commercial vehicles, or may impose limitations as to the weight thereof. Said authority for weight limitations has been granted to the County Board under the provisions of 625 ILCS 5/15-316.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kendall County Board hereby reduces and restricts the gross weight of vehicles operating on Eldamain Road, from a point 7100 ft. north of U.S. Route 34 to Galena Road, to a maximum of 30,000 pounds (15 tons) gross weight.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that garbage trucks, school buses, and other vehicles exempted by law, that provide service to residents living along Eldamain Road in the area so described, shall be exempt from the weight restriction contained herein, but shall conform in all other ways to existing State regulations and requirements that govern said vehicles.
